GROUP A

1. 5 Objective type questions without multiple choice to be answered from the texts prescribed: (5x1 = 5)
 - a. Which plateau is mentioned in the subtitle of ‘Tales of Hazaribagh’?
 - b. Who tells the legend of the Baskerville family to Sherlock Holmes?
 - c. Who is revealed to be the killer in ‘The Hound of the Baskervilles’?
 - d. Which department did Ryan, Alok and Hari belong to in ‘Five Point Someone’?
2. 2 questions to be answered compulsorily in short answer type out of 4 questions asked from the texts prescribed: (5x2 = 10)
 - a. What was the curse upon the Baskerville family?
 - b. Why did Mihir Vatsa decide to move back to Hazaribagh?
 - c. What are the themes of ‘Five Point Someone’?
 - d. Why did Ryan, Alok and Hari steal the question Paper in ‘Five Point Someone’?

GROUP B

1. 4 long type subjective questions to be answered out of the choice of 6 questions from all the texts prescribed (Two from each prescribed text)
(15x4 = 60)
 - a. Discuss the friendship of Sherlock Holmes and Dr. John Watson as shown in ‘The Hound of the Baskervilles’.
 - b. Write on ‘The Hound of the Baskervilles’ as a detective novel?
 - c. Explain the significance of the title, “Five Point Someone”.
 - d. Write a note on ‘Tales of Hazaribagh’ as an example of Travel Writing.
 - e. Despite being set in an IIT, the story of ‘Five Point Someone’ has touched the heart of the average Indian youth. What could be the reasons behind such popularity?
 - f. Comment on the use of autobiographical method as used by Mihir Vatsa in ‘Tales of Hazaribagh’.
