The Awareness Module will consist of four Units and each unit will have 7 to 8 hrs. of lectures and 4 to 5 hrs. of activities. Each Unit will be supported by at least TWO (02) video lectures of approximately 30 minutes each. The content will be developed in Hindi and Lectures will also be recorded in Hindi and placed on the website of Vinoba Bhave University for free access by the students. Each unit will be covered in approximately Three Thousand words reading material. The total text material will be approximately Twenty Thousand words. The text will be placed on the Vinoba Bhave University website for free access.

Course Learning Outcomes:-

- To prepare the learners for their roles and responsibilities as effective citizens of a democratic society.

- To raise awareness among the learners the impact of food on the body and balanced well as the role of eating habits.
- To raise awareness on the 'Triguna' – 'Satwik', 'Tamasik' and 'Rajasik' guna (properties) and six (Rasas): sweet, sour, salty, pungent, bitter, and astringent of food.

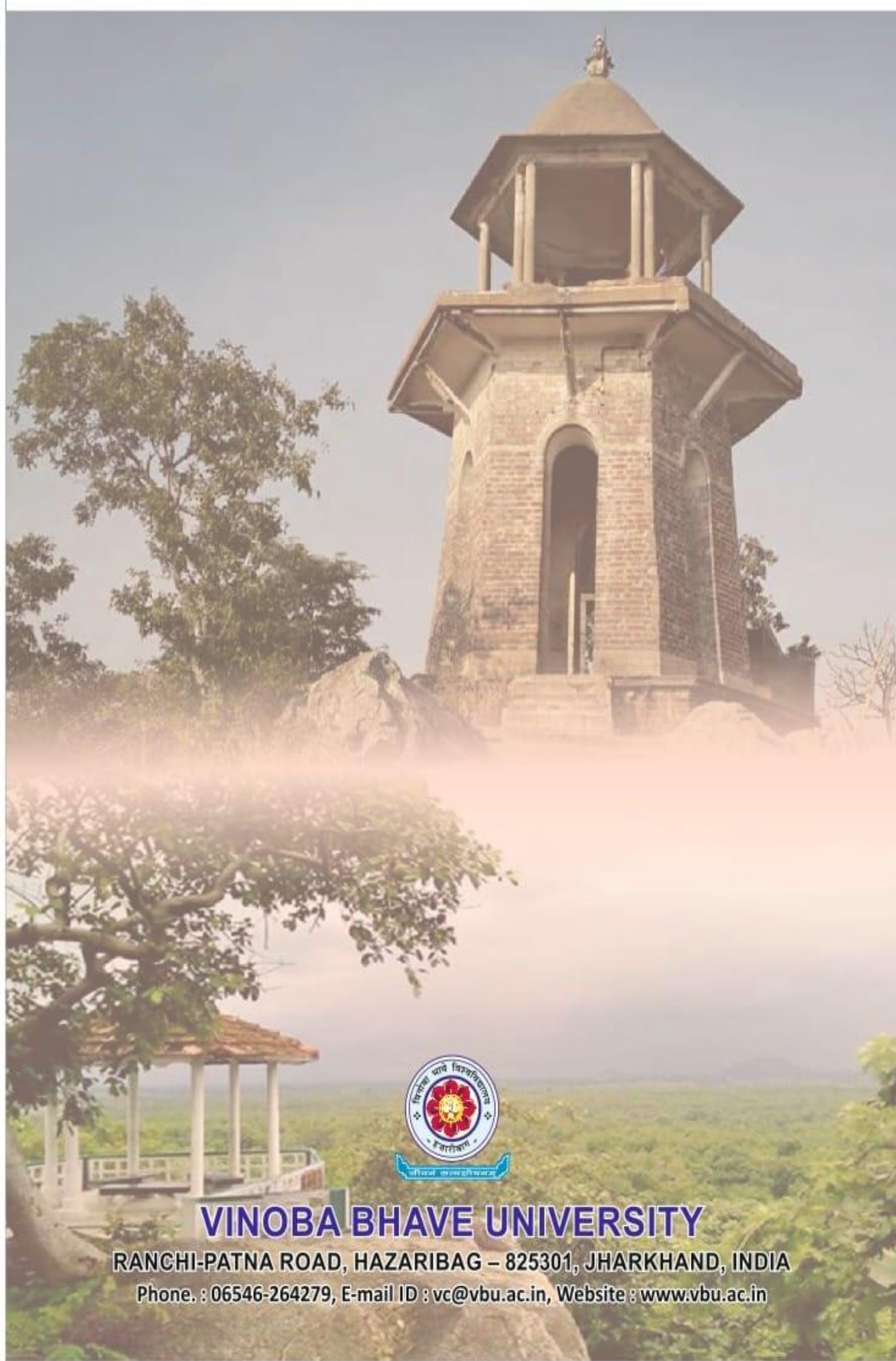
